8	MR. JONES: No.

10	MR. JONES: No.
11	DEBBIE: Not turning in my homework?
12	MR. JONES: Try again.
13	DEBBIE: Uhwell, uhoh no!
14	MR. JONES: Yes?
15	DEBBIE: You saw me?
16	MR. JONES: That's right, Debbie. I saw you.
17	DEBBIE: But Mr. Jones, that was last week.
18	MR. JONES: I have a good memory.
19	DEBBIE: Why are you waiting until now to confront me
20	about it?
21	MR. JONES: I've been trying to decide how to handle this
22	delicate situation.
23	DEBBIE: Delicately?
24	MR. JONES: Firmly.
25	DEBBIE: Uh-oh.
26	MR. JONES: Debbie, did you actually think what you did
27	was funny?
28	DEBBIE: (Trying not to laugh) No, sir.
29	MR. JONES: Then may I ask why?
30	DEBBIE: Why? Welluh
31	MR. JONES: Listen, you're not leaving this room until we get
32	to the bottom of this. I want to know why you did what

35	MR. JONES: Not funny, Debbie.
