6 DEDE: Oh, so now you're blaming me for you falling in love  
7 with him?  
8 LUCY: I'm not in love with him!  
9 DEDE: You were this morning! On the way to the bus, all I  
10 heard was how you couldn't wait until first period so you  
11 could see Bryan!  
12 LUCY: Maybe it was that fall on the trampoline last week.  
13 DEDE: What do you mean?  
14 LUCY: I must have damaged my head.  
15 DEDE: Lucy! You've always been deranged!  
16 LUCY: Shut up!  
17 DEDE: So are you going to tell me what happened?  
18 LUCY: I said I didn't want to talk about it!  
19 DEDE: Fine. Bryan is one of my friends, you know.  
20 LUCY: So?  
21 DEDE: So I could call him tonight for a little chat. Ask if he's  
22 met my new friend, Lucy.  
23 LUCY: You wouldn't!  
24 DEDE: I would!  
25 LUCY: That's sorry!  
26 DEDE: (*Sympathetically*) Lucy, I can see you're in distress.

30 DEDE: But you're still suffering internally.  
31 LUCY: Leave me alone.  
32 DEDE: Wouldn't you help me if I was the one hurting?  
33 LUCY: I'm not hurting.  
34 DEDE: Sure you are. I can see it in your eyes.  
35 LUCY: I'm mad, that's what I am!

1 DEDE: Of course you are! Mad and hurt. I understand.  
2 LUCY: No you don't! You don't even know what happened.  
3 DEDE: I can just imagine.  
4 LUCY: OK! What do you imagine happened?  
5 DEDE: Well, you had on your new outfit today, hoping to get  
6 Bryan's attention and it didn't work. And knowing you,  
7 you tried everything from walking in front of him a  
8 hundred times to dropping your notebook at his feet.  
9 LUCY: How did you know?  
10 DEDE: I know you, silly.  
11 LUCY: Well, it's worse than you imagined.  
12 DEDE: Bryan wasn't a gentleman? He didn't pick up your  
13 notebook for you?  
14 LUCY: Oh, he was a gentleman all right.  
15 DEDE: He picked up your notebook?
