5	other, enters Stage Right. CHARACTER 1 enters Stage Left.

7	MAN: OK, bud, hand over the important papers.
8	CHARACTER 1: What important papers? I don't know what
9	you're talking about.
10	MAN: I said, hand over the important papers. Now. Make it
11	snappy or I'll shoot.
12	CHARACTER 1: Look fellow, I don't know what you're
13	talking about. (MAN shoots CHARACTER 1, who falls to the
14	floor, dead. Enter CHARACTER 2.)
15	MAN: Hey, you, let me have the important papers.
16	CHARACTER 2: What important papers? I don't have any
17	important papers.
18	MAN: I'm not kidding, buster. I need those important papers.
19	Hand them over.
20	CHARACTER 2: I don't know who you are or where your
21	important papers are, but I don't have any important
22	papers.
23	MAN: I'm warning you. If I don't get those important papers,
24	I'll shoot.
25	CHARACTER 2: And I'm telling you the truth. I don't have
26	any important papers. (MAN shoots CHARACTER 2, who
27	falls to the floor, dead. Enter CHARACTER 3.)
28	MAN: All right, let's have them. Give me those important
29	papers immediately.
30	CHARACTER 3: What important papers?
31	MAN: Another smart one, eh? This is your only warning. If
32	you don't turn over the important papers to me, I'll shoot.
33	CHARACTER 3: Man, I wish I could, but how can I give you
34	the important papers when I don't have any important
35	papers?

1	MAN: Don't say I didn't warn you. (MAN shoots CHARACTER				
2	3, who falls to the floor, dead. Enter CHARACTER 4.)				
3	MAN: Hey, you, give me the important papers. I'm getting				
4	tired of this.				
5	CHARACTER 4: Sure. Anything you say. Wait just a minute.				
6	(CHARACTER 4 runs Offstage and immediately runs back				
7	Onstage carrying a roll of toilet tissue, which he waves about				
8	dramatically.)				
9	MAN: Ah, at last, I have the important papers!

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3	CHARACTERS: Three boys.				
4	SETTING: The three boys are lost in the desert. They are staggering				
5	in exhaustion from heat and drought. The only prop is a glass				
6	of water placed on something that puts it in full view of the				
7	audience.

9	BOY 1:	Oh, that sun is unbearable.			
10	BOY 2:	Man, this is the hottest place I ever saw.			
11	BOY 3:	I'd give anything for some water.			
12	BOY 1:	Water, cool, clear water.			
13	BOY 2:	How long have we been lost in this desert, anyway?			
14	BOY 3:	I don't know, but it seems like forever.			
15	BOY 1:	Water, oh, for some water.			
16	BOY 2:	I don't know if I can make it much further. I'm about			
17	to	die.			
18	BOY 3:	Come on, we've got to make it.			
19	BOY 1:	Water, water.			
20	BOY 2:	If there were just a little shade and one small cool spot.			
21	BOY 3:	I'd give my right arm for some water.			
22	BOY 1:	What did I ever do to deserve being lost in the desert?			
23	BOY 2:	Water, give us water.			
24	BOY 3:	Yea, just a little water.			
25	BOY 1:	Look! Over there! Are my eyes playing tricks on me?
